Step by Step

<u>Day 1</u>

Arrive in New Plymouth, where we'll arrange your transfer to Nice Hotel. After settling in, enjoy lunch and a group briefing at 1 PM, followed by a guided tour of Pukekura Park and visit a local brewery. Return to Nice Hotel for dinner.

<u>Day 2</u>

Breakfast is served at Nice Hotel. We'll meet at 9:30 AM to depart for the day's activities, starting with visits to showcase some of the best gardens from the festival. Next, enjoy a scenic walk and bird watching at Lake Mangamahoe, followed by lunch at Pikopiko Eatery, then a private reading with a local author and an exclusive book signing — complete with your own signed copy.

In the afternoon, explore three local art galleries, including the Govett Brewster Art Gallery and Len Lye Centre. Then join a gin crafting workshop/tasting at a local distillery. End the day with a dinner at Social Kitchen.

Day 3

This morning, choose between a gentle stroll at your own pace or an E-Bike tour of the foreshore walkway. The E-Bike tour will highlight landmarks like the Te Rewa Rewa Bridge, Fitzroy Beach, the central city wind wand, and the Port of Taranaki. If you prefer to explore at your own pace, we'll provide a list of nearby highlights to discover.

Enjoy picturesque views of the Tasman sea with lunch at The Bach Café, followed by a visit to St Mary's Church and a hidden gem garden not featured in the festival, along with other New Plymouth highlights.

For dinner enjoy Chinese-style shared cuisine. End the evening with star gazing at New Plymouth's observatory.







Day by Day

After Breakfast we will take you on a guided tour of Stratford, including the iconic glockenspiel clock tower and local parks. Stop in at Fenton Street Art Collective for a coffee before a quick stop in Eltham, on our way to Hāwera for lunch. In the afternoon, we stop in at Tawhiti Museum before taking in the scenic beauty of Dawson Falls on Mount Taranaki and explore the quirky Possum Factory. Then we head back to Nice Hotel to unwind before dinner at the Hour Glass Restaurant.

<u>Day 5.</u>

Start the day with breakfast at Nice Hotel before being picked up for the day's adventures. Begin with an optional Chaddy's Charters experience, followed by a relaxing stop at Back Beach. Enjoy lunch and a wine tasting at the stunning Okurukuru Vineyard Bistro, then explore Ōakura township and take a peaceful walk through Lucy's Gully and the Redwood forest. Throughout the day, visit a selection of local gardens featured in the Taranaki Garden Festival. Return to the hotel to refresh before a private jewellery-making workshop, visit another local brewery, then finish the day with dinner at a local favourite restaurant, Arborio.

<u>Day 6.</u>

Enjoy a final breakfast at Nice Hotel before gathering for a tour wrap-up at 9:30 AM, reflecting on the highlights of your Taranaki journey. For those with later departures, an optional morning activity will be available. Transfers to New Plymouth Airport will be arranged throughout the morning to ensure a smooth and stress-free departure.
